## Road closure extended

The restriction on heavy vehicles from entering Thane-Ghodbunder Road has been extended from April 29 to May 1. The closure has been extended to facilitate the ongoing maintenance work. While heavy vehicles are strictly prohibited, light vehicles will be re-routed in phases via the opposite lane. The Gaymukh ghat area is expected to experience significant traffic congestion during this period. The order does not apply to essential service vehicles like police or fire brigade automobiles and ambulances. The traffic police have warned against the unauthorised use of the wrong side of the road, particularly from Varsave Police Chowki to Nirkendra Ghat.

## Now, Customs man arrested in drug cartel investigation

As the Navi Mumbai police probes the major drug cartel, which is said to be operating from the US and Thailand, more skeletons are tumbling out of the closet with each passing day. After the recent arrest of two police personnel, the special investigation team (SIT) on Tuesday arrested Prashant Gaur, 40, the Customs superintendent officer who headed the western zone. He is the tenth accused to be arrested.

In its April 29 edition, the FPJ had reported how the probe encountered another dramatic turn with the arrest of constable Sachin Bhulerkar and Sanjay Phulkar from the Anti-Narcotics Unit ANU. In a prior startling development, Gurnam Chikhar, 50, a builder and father of prime suspect Chikhar brothers—Dheeraj and Naveen—had shot himself dead on April 25 after being 'fed up' of answering to the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and ANU. He was called to record his statement on April 19.

Gaur, a resident of Kharghar, allegedly let the 'air couriers' containing hydro drugs without scrutiny, and neither raised any alert or suspicion. The drug cartel was exposed on April 14 when the police seized contraband worth Rs14.43 lakh. In the course of the investigation apart from the trio officials, those arrested, so far, are Ashish Gaware, 22, Ahmad Oli, 23, Sahil Lambhe, 27, Sujit Bangare, 28, Kamal

Chandwani alias KK, 56, Ankit Patel, 37 and Rinkul Kumar Patel, 39.

During a raid on April 14, ANU inspector Sandeep Nigade nabbed Gaware and Oli with 1.15 kg of traditional ganja as well as 719 grams of hydro ganja from Nerul. "During their interrogation, we found that the drugs were being imported from the US and Thailand," said additional commissioner of police Deepak Sakore. Considering the vastness of the network, a SIT was formed to trace the chain of accused.

The police has found that Bangare, a Senwads resident, who also happens to be two-times national player of hockey, ordered for the drug consignments from abroad. The suppliers from abroad, apparently Chikhar brothers, used to send the contraband via air courier. "The courier first reaches Indian Postal that dispatches it to the respective zonal cus-

tom office as per the address. The ones meant for Maharashtra are sent to the western zone, which was headed by Gaur," said Kale. Gaur was allegedly provided the consignment numbers beforehand and in this manner, he cleared the drug parcel without scrutiny, he added.

The couriers used to be on false names and KK, a Kharghar resident, used to make fake Aadhaar cards using his photo and pose as the receiver. He would then take the courier and hand it over to Bangare. The latter made cash payments to both the Patels, who operated as Angadia. "The angadia used to accept the payment and transfer USDT to US or Thailand from where the courier was sent," the officer added. Gaware, Oli and Lambhe, all three from Nerul, operated as peddlers.

Constables Bhulerkar and Phulkar are said to have been in constant touch with KK. As per the police sources, the duo was tasked with 'protecting' the cartel from any cases and arrests. Bhulerkar has been allegedly in touch with KK for close to a year and Phulkar joined the chain much later. They have till now been paid close to a total of Rs10 lakh, said sources, adding Gaur was being paid Rs1 lakh for every 1 kg drug passed by him. "There are more accused wanted and we are still investigating to understand the chain of distribution of the drugs," assistant commissioner of police Bhauashe Dhole said.

## Project revival plan gives hope to home buyers in Panvel

The conciliators are mandated to hold discussions with all stakeholders, suggest measures to ensure completion of all towers and secure possession of homes for the buyers without any litigation. Sudhakar Deshmukh, MaharERA director, has been appointed as amicus curiae to assist the two conciliators.

According to a press note issued by Anita Khanolkar, MGP secretary, a similar situation arose with the DSK Sadaphul housing project in Talegaon, Pune, which had come to a standstill. At that time, MaharERA had appointed Advocate Deshpande and Dr Hiramanandani as special conciliators. The duo had submitted a blueprint to MaharERA, following which the buyers finally received possession of their homes. The duo's experience will prove valuable in steering the Talaja project towards completion, Khanolkar added.

## NGO seeks action against actress for 'consuming protected wildlife'

She claimed to have eaten meat of protected wildlife species such as mouse deer, rabbits, wild boar, monitor lizard and porcupine. This sends a wrong message to the public and constitutes an offence under various sections of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, the NGO added.

It sought that the interview should be considered as an admission of guilt and that the relevant sections of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002, (Vigilance) "We have received the complaint. It has been forwarded by the chief conservator of forests to the deputy conservator for inquiry. The actress will be called for investigation soon," said Rathod.
